Church History

In 1954 Béla Nyika from Windsor organized the Greek Catholic congregation, which one in the first time held the



Mass in the St. Ladislaus church, because they did not have own church building. György Gyülvészi donated the the land for the community where the church was built in 1956. The first permanent pastor became József Erdei in 1959 and he moved in the new built parson home. To help finance the church, the congregation made annually picnic, different type dinners, and exhibitions. In 1969 became István Bodnár to be a new pastor. In this time the community had about 100 families. Pastor Bodnár held two liturgies on every Sunday which was on Hungarian and English language, and he organized the Hungarian School and Hungarian events. The number of the congregation is less in every year, but on the holydays over a hundred people coming together.
