Church History

The parish history can be traced to 1936 when two clergymen, Istvan Boros and Andras Sandory, arrived from Europe. Seeing the lack of ecclesiastical services



for Hungarian Greek Catholics in their own language, they invited all the locals for Christmas services at St. Nicholas Russian Orthodox Cathedral on 97th Street. The turnout was poor, but the following year enough people gathered to form a parish and purchase the little sanctuary, formerly home to the Congregation. The church was consecrated in 1937, and Constantine Roskovics became its official pastor the next year.
