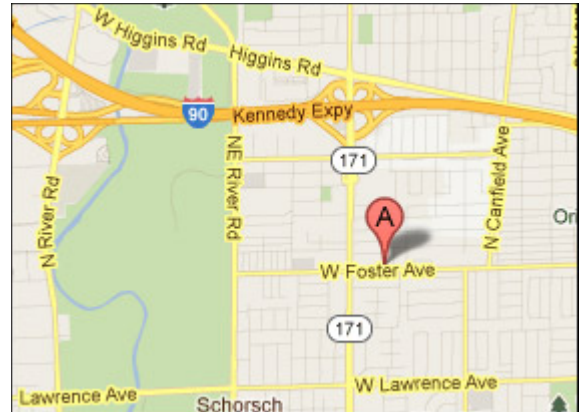

In 1914 on the west side of Chicago was founded a Hungarian Reformed Church. One year later the congregation bought an old German Evangelic church building on the Carroll Avenue.
