Church History

The Hungarian Baptis mission was founded in 1908, at the begenning the congregaton held the mass at house of István Pető in the Medina street. The first Baptist



Church was built in 1913 in the Thaddeus street. In 1931 the congregation and the missoin of Highland Park was melted together, but the church in the Thaddeus street got to small, hence they buoght a new church building in the Vanderbilt street witch one was in service for the next 48 years. In 1976, when Pastor András Herjeczki became the new leader for the sorority, the congregation sold the church building. One and a half year later they bought the church in the 1362 Chandler street. The opening ceremonz was held at March 12 1978.
