

Church History

The First Hungarian Reformed Church is a handsome building on Johnston Avenue, and was erected in 1903. This is the first Hungarian Reformed Church in



North America. And this is the original congregation that still gathers in this same building, all their years of existence. This situation is VERY unusual for this city. This is also the last Hungarian Reformed church left in existence within the city of Pittsburgh proper, although there are a few outside the borders.

Pastor Ilona Komjáthy is 5th generation Hungarian, from New Jersey. She used to be the organist when her husband was the minister here. When he died very suddenly of a heart attack 14 yrs ago, she went to seminary school, and was ordained.
