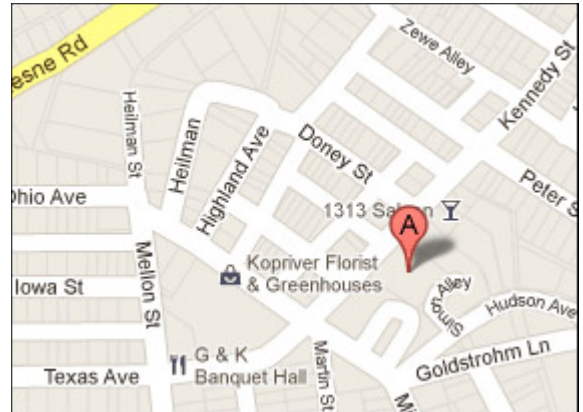

Church History

Hungarian Reformed tradition was brought to America by immigrants and their pastors. After World War I no more support could come from the mother church in Hungary.
