Church History

Only about a dozen people are found at Vintondale Hungarian Reformed Church on Main Street.

That congregation dates to 1916, and its first church was dedicated in the early 1920s on land donated by a mining company. It burned in 1929 and was rebuilt the following year.

The Vintondale church holds services once a month and an average of 15 to 20 people attend.
