Church History

On April 18, 1893, the church society was organized in the Methodist Episcopalian church building (West Avenue) with about 35 members. Mr. Dániel Bárdos became the president of the first consistory. This organizing meeting was interested primarily in how to raise funds for purchasing suitable property and building their own church. They were able to purchase a tract of land, 45' x 105', on the Snowden estate in Ely Avenue for \$270.00.
